THE IMPORTANCE OF BEING BAPTIZED

I. Why should I be baptized?

1. To follow the example set by Jesus.
2. Because Christ commanded it.
3. It demonstrates that I really am a believer.

Mark 1:9
Matthew 28:19-20
Acts 18:8
1 John 2:3

II. What is the meaning of baptism?

1. It illustrates Christ's death and resurrection.
2. It illustrates my new life as a Christian

1 Corinthians 15:3-4
2 Corinthians 5:17
Romans 6:4

Baptism doesn't make you a believer — it shows that you already believe. Baptism does not "save" you, only your faith in Christ does that. Baptism is like a wedding ring — it's the outward symbol of the commitment you made in your heart.

III. Why be baptized by immersion?

1. Because Christ was baptized that way.
2. Every baptism in the New Testament was by immersion.
3. The word "Baptize" means to immerse or dip under water.
4. It symbolizes a burial and resurrection.

Matthew 3:16
Acts 8:38-39

IV. Who should be baptized?

1. Every person who has believed in Christ.

Acts 2:41
Acts 8:12-13

**At CRBC, we wait until our children are old enough to believe and understand the true meaning of baptism before we baptize them. It is also a membership requirement that every member must have been baptized the way Jesus demonstrated, even though many of us were "confirmed" or "sprinkled" as children.*

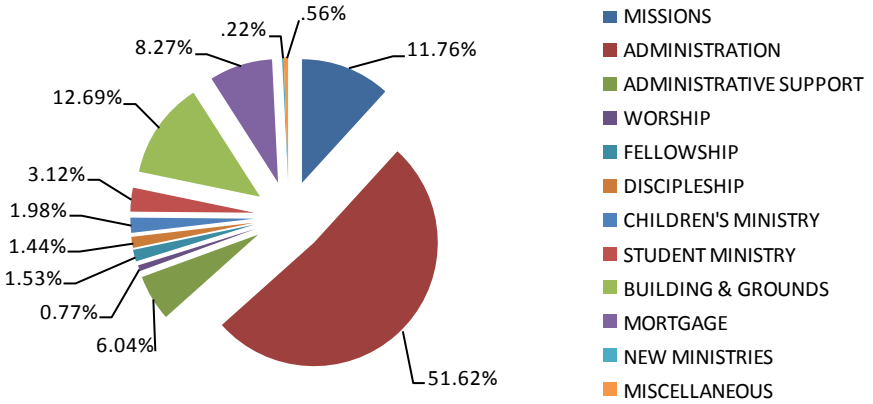

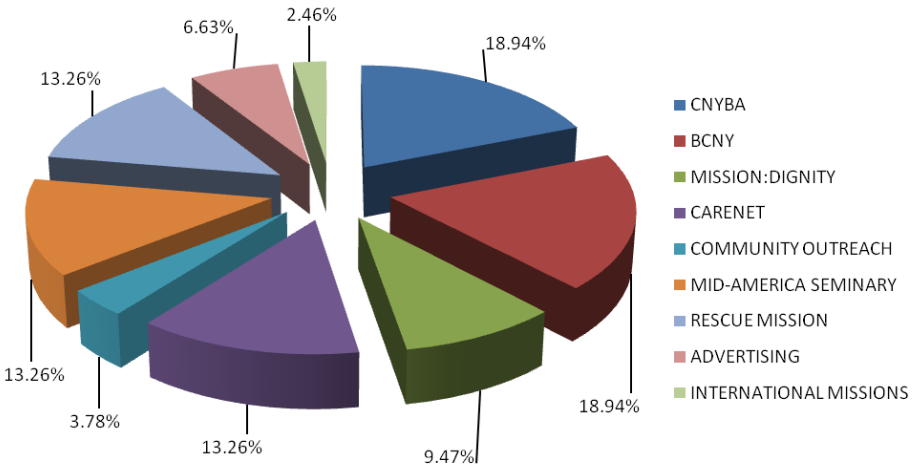
