*From Care Net Pregnancy Center:*

Missy contacted our office last year. At 32 years old, she had never been pregnant. Her closest friends are her family, and they live in PA. Missy was married to a much younger man who had not been faithful and fathered another child during the same time frame as Missy's pregnancy. Missy wanted to have an abortion. She was scared, isolated, and felt incapable of raising a child. She wept tears of desperation. We talked for over two hours and by the end of our session she decided that having an abortion would be worse than carrying the baby and placing him for adoption. Four months after making that decision, devastation set in as Missy learned that her husband's mother stood in the way. She wanted to raise Missy's baby and was making it impossible for Missy to follow through with her decision. Missy was so frustrated that she began to hate her baby and considered a late term abortion. After months of not hearing from Missy, she dropped in one afternoon to say hello and to donate baby items to help other girls who come to Care Net! The child that she was so close to aborting is now the apple of her eye. She adores her baby boy and could not stop showing him off to us. This is the fruit of your generosity to Care Net. Thank you for all you do to help the moms, dads, and babies God sends our way.
