A CALL TO A NEW MINISTRY

According to the American Cancer Society, over 12 million people in the United States are living with or have been personally diagnosed with cancer. Every year 1.5 million more people receive a cancer diagnosis. That mean that in a church of 200 people, approximately eight people are living with cancer and two more will be diagnosed with it every year. Each of these individuals has family members and caregivers that are affected as well.

The Cancer Care-Our Hope ministry is centered on bringing God's hope to patients and their caregivers, family and friends. This requires understanding of the impact of cancer, how people react to it and how God has called His people to respond. Above all it requires us to have within ourselves and unfeigned hope that we can take to those in need. It involves prayer, counsel, visits and assistance as it is centered in God's love.

This new opportunity for ministry may be calling you. It is a specific seed planted in the heart by God. This ministry is an expression of God's love and hope in us, patterned after His words, His direction and His heart. If your heart goes out to those impacted by cancer and you believe God wants their hearts to be filled with hope, then it is time to begin watering the seeds planted in your own heart.
