Fasting and Praying

There are 35 Bible fasts: from not giving a time limit 1,3,7,14,21 and 40 days.

Acts 14:23, did not give time limit on fasting and praying 2 Sam 3; 35, David fasted and prayed for 1 day Esther 4:13-9-3, Esther and Mordecai fasted and prayed 3 days

1 Sam 31; 13, Israel fasted and prayed 7 days.

Acts 27; 33-37, Paul and 276 men fasted and prayed 14 days Matt 4:1-11, Jesus fasted and prayed 40 days.

The disciples asked the Lord why they could not heal a lunatic boy. Jesus said: because of your unbelief...howbeit this kind goeth not out but by prayer and fasting (matt 17; 14-21.)

I'm asking that the church help with 3 things:

Fasting and praying on Wednesday from 1 pm until 6 pm. Refresh yourself and at 7 pm pray for 15 minutes at home or at the church.

That we get maybe two praying partners and pray for them.

Also pray for our leaders in the church.

I realize that some of our members may be able to hold out for 5 hours, please fast as much as you can. Some have to take meds, etc.
