COLD KITS

On Saturday, January 27th, all are invited to hand out cold kits to people in need in Downtown Utica. A cold kit is a bag filled with the things someone would need to survive the harsh Central New York winter.

These kits include hats, gloves, scarves, hand warmer packets, tissues, chap stick, nonperishable foods, hand sanitizer, etc.. Every year in January, we bundle up and hand out these kits with gospel tracts inside as well as trying to talk to, connect with, and pray with as many people as possible.

In years past we have been able to bless some homeless folks, a woman who was digging through the trash with her little daughter, a young boy who had no jacket and many more. Anybody in the church interested in joining us is more than welcome (children 6th grade or below must be accompanied by a parent or guardian).
