
If anyone has equipment to donate to someone in need; instead of throwing it away, please consider storing them to provide the ability for someone in need to have access to them.

The Parent/Child Dedication

A special opportunity for Christian parents to publicly dedicate themselves to raise their children according to Scripture, and offer their children to the loving care and keeping of the Lord. The practice of this dedication is found in the Bible when Hannah presents Samuel to the Lord (1 Samuel 1:28) and when Joseph and Mary present Jesus at the temple (Luke 2:22). The numerous Scripture references concerning parenting help us to realize its importance to God. From the very beginning of the family, He established the best plans for children and their parents, and He shares them in His Word, the Bible. For example, God commands parents to love Him and His commands, and then teach these to their children so that they may also have a relationship with the Lord: Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength. These commandments that I give you today are to be upon your hearts. Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. Tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. Write them on the door frames of your houses and on your gates.

Deuteronomy 6:5-9

Parent/Child Dedication is...

An opportunity to thank God for the precious gift of your child. An opportunity to publicly declare your intentions to raise your child in a Christian home. Although many of you have already done that in your hearts, the public announcement makes you accountable to hundreds of people.

A benchmark you can return to time and time again. A family dedication, where the parents commit themselves to abide by biblical principles and to raise their children according to God's standards. Not only are you dedicating your child to God, you are dedicating yourselves, as parents, to Christ and the church. You are committing yourselves to maintaining a Christian home, where Christ is honored and the Word of God is held in reverence. A child's first impression of God comes from you, so you must strive to live Christlike lives at all times. Children sense our commitment to the Lord and are far more perceptive than we sometimes realize. For that reason, you need to be diligent in your own personal relationship with the Lord and the study of His Word. Train up a child in the way he should go, but first be sure to go that way yourself.

What About Baptism?

Parent/Child Dedication at Crosspoint Church does not involve baptism. Biblical baptism is meant to take place at a time when an individual makes a personal decision to follow Christ and is old enough to repent of sin and confess Jesus publicly.

Some people think that if a child dies before being baptized he will not go to heaven. This belief is not Biblical and does not support the nature of God taught throughout the Bible. See 2 Samuel 12:23

Membership at Crosspoint Church is not required. Parents do not set a Christlike example by living together unmarried. Therefore, co-habiting parents will be advised to wait until they are married to dedicate their child. We encourage you to invite relatives and friends to this special event. Flash photography and video cameras are allowed during the dedication portion of the service.
